This will be the same format as previous years, with the exception that we will be bringing in almost all of the portables from the main course. We will be offering some challenging courses including using some of the Preliminary and Training level fences, and will also have a course of logs for those just starting out. We will offer a clinic on Saturday that will consist of a 90-minute group lesson over fences, including schooling over many of the mini cross-country jumps.

On Sunday, we will have a competition consisting of Dressage, Mini cross country course and Stadium Jumping. You can enter all of the components or select only portions. There will be prizes and awards!

Four Levels will be offered:

Entry - newbies, babies, first-timers etc... Cross-country consists of jumping (or walking over) 18" logs - great introduction level. Stadium jumps all cross rails.

Starter - jumps in the 2' to 2'6" range - no ditches or unnatural elements.

Pre-Training - jumps at 3' with a few cross-country questions including ditches and skinnies.

Training (with some Prelim fences) - for the experienced competitors we will offer a great warm up for the season.
